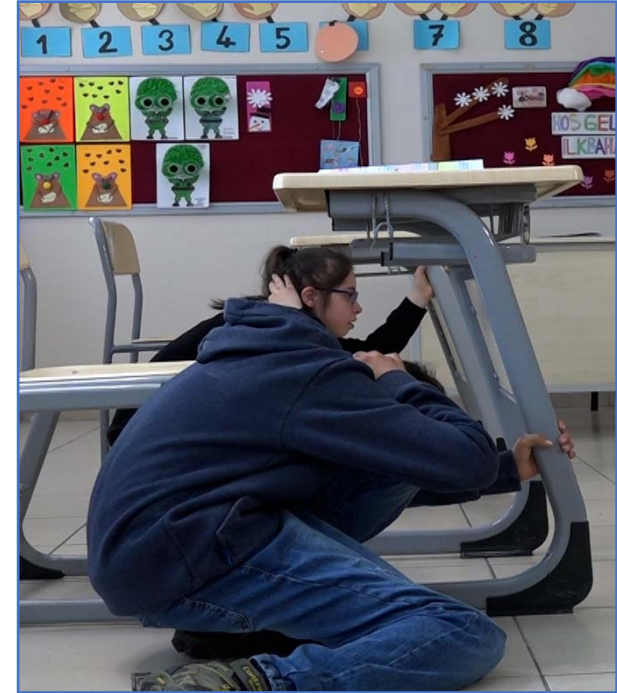




The earthquake may happen while I am at school.
